Cakes, Pies and Candy: Saturday, October 24th - Each family will be responsible for bringing in 3 cakes, pies or baked goods to be used as dessert for the meal or the cake walk booth.

Booth Set-UP/Work Day: Saturday, October 24th - Each family is required to work a minimum of 2 hours on Saturday in preparation of the Fiesta. Parents will check in at the information booth on Saturday from 8am until the work is done, which usually winds done by 2pm. Please make sure you sign in and out, the information booth will let you know where your helpful hands will be needed.

Sunday Booth Work - All parents are required to work 2 hours on the day of the Fiesta. Sign up sheets have been made available for all parents to sign up for a midway booth, first come first serve. Please be on time to your post and respect one another time. Thank you in advance for signing up.

T-Shirts/Costumes: T-Shirts - Shirts with a logo designed by ACS students will be made available by donation or to purchase, shirts will go on sale by September 15th and will be sold for \$10. The children will be able to wear this shirt on blue jean/shirt day at school. Parents should get a shirt as well and show your ACS support. **Costumes** - Costumes welcomed!! The kids can wear their favorite festive costumes and parents are encouraged to dress up while working their booth. If parents are not ready to do the costume thing then a Fiesta T-Shirt is encouraged. Let's have fun.

Raffle Tickets:

Each ACS student will receive 100 tickets to sell before the Oktober Fiesta. ACS children and families are encouraged to sell more of course and the top selling students will be named King and Queen, the second top sellers will be named Prince and Princess. This royal court will represent ACS in the Veterans Day Parade. Parents will be allowed to sell tickets on their own and each class will have the opportunity to sell on designated dates in various locations set up by the Raffle Committee.
