Title of experiment

Purpose of the study

Hypothesis-What do you think will happen

Materials used in the experiments

Procedures-step-by-step instructions to carry the experiment

Results- What happened

Conclusion- Is your hypothesis true or false and why

I encourage you to help your child with his/her project, but to allow your child to do most of the work. Remember, the final project needs to reflect your child's creativity and work. Also, as part of the grade, your child must be able to discuss the project, so your child needs to understand all aspects.
